The Harris County Pct. 4 Victim Assistance Program is committed to restoring the respect and dignity of crime victims through crisis intervention, counseling, advocacy, education, information and referral. Every effort will be made to provide services to individuals who request assistance from law enforcement

Addressing the needs of a victim will in turn facilitate the victims' and witnesses' willingness and ability to cooperate with the Criminal Justice System in the investigation and prosecution of the crimes.

Special consideration is also directed to law enforcement officers and the community in educating them in the victimization process and recognizing the needs and rights of crime victims.



What Services Are Available for Victims of Crime?

- ★ Crisis intervention and advocacy throughout the criminal investigation and judicial process.
- ★ Information regarding case status.
- ★ Referrals for counseling, legal aid, financial assistance, emergency housing, food and clothing.
- ★ Court accompaniment.
- ★ Assistance in filing Crime Victims' Compensation Claims.
- ★ Community education and awareness. Assistance in filing charges and obtaining Emergency Protective Orders
- ★ Helping citizens who request assistance of a non-criminal nature.
